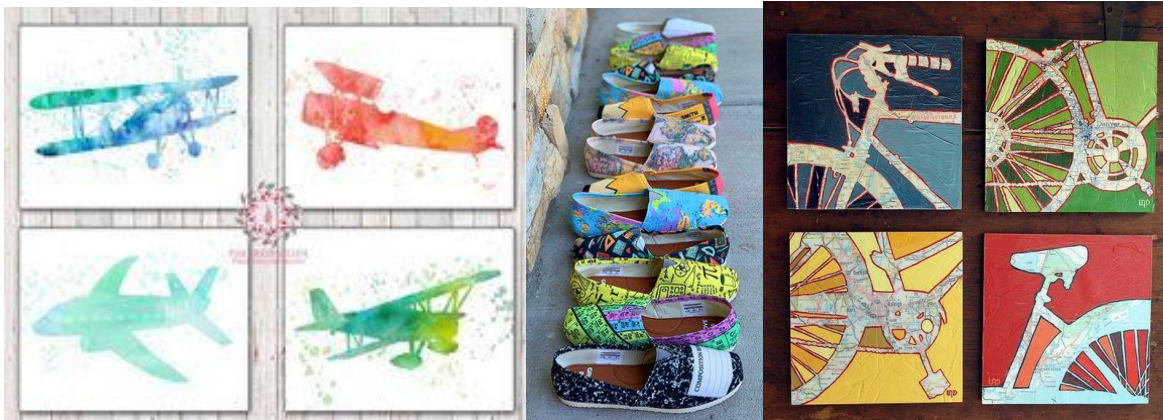

Pee Wee Tee Ball - Boys and Girls ages 4/5

The emphasis for pee wee ball is on the basic rules, skills and sportsmanship of baseball. A tee and soft ball will be used to assist in the teaching of this game. Kids need to bring a mitt. Kids are welcome to bring their own helmets. Team assignments, parent coaches and schedules will be communicated after registration. **COACHES NEEDED-this program is coached by parents!** Coaches will be given a packet of age appropriate practice techniques to run for 15 minutes before the game. **For ages 4 & 5.** Ages may be mixed on teams depending on numbers. Each team plays 1 game each Sat. (if correct # of teams.)

Coach Pitch -Boys and Girls ages 6/7

This league, for ages 6 and 7, introduces the skill of hitting a ball pitched by a coach. **PARENT COACHES run this program.** This league also improves throwing mechanics, catching balls thrown by other fielders and fielding both ground balls and fly balls. A soft core softball will be used. One year of tee ball is recommended! The first 15 minutes of the program will be used for practice with the remaining 30 minutes for games. Teams, schedules and coaching assignments will be communicated after registration.

Little League ages 8-9 and 10-12

Ages 8-9 and 10-12. It is recommended to have experience with Coach Pitch to register! It is also recommended that the player has at least 1 prior year of little league to join the 10-12 level. This baseball league offers advanced skill development in all areas of the game and challenging game competition. Teams are coached AND umpired by the high school Recreation Staff. There are two practices per week and 1 game day per week.

Schedules, teams and game rules will be provided once teams are drafted. The high school staff drafts the teams to make teams as even as possible. Practices will continue the week of June 7th with games beginning the week of June 14th. Register using CURRENT 2020-2021 Grade. **Schedules are subject to change based on enrollment.**
